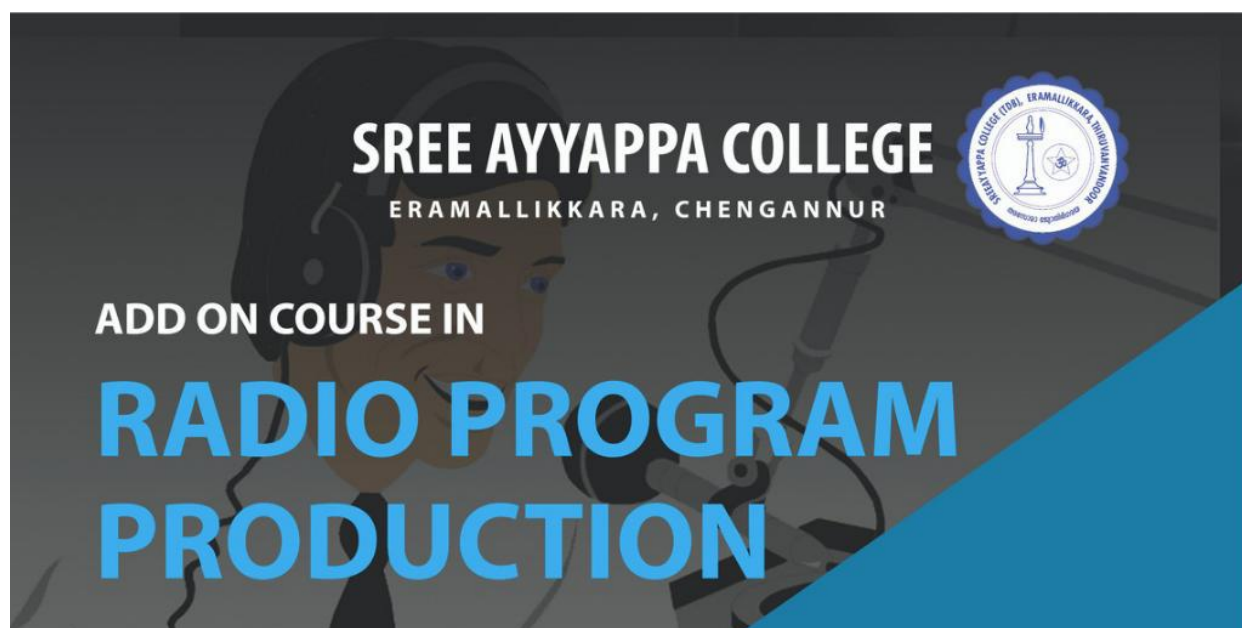

Introduction

The future of radio and its technology in the age of images and digital technology has always been questioned. However, radio has adapted to the tastes of younger generations by incorporating newer technologies. The audio programs thus broadcast on various digital platforms are widely popular across the globe.

Considering the increased reception of radio among the Indian youth, the Department of English and Media Studies, in association with Media Club and IQAC, offers an add-on course on Radio Program Production. Radio experts from the AIR stations in Kerala will conduct the classes, and they will also serve as the consulting firm assisting us in putting the course into action. This comprehensive course aims to provide an understanding of the basics of radio program production and various genres of radio programs. It exposes students to the radio broadcast industry; technical and creative aspects of radio program production; and training in radio jockeying.

The course mainly focuses on the important technical and performance-based elements like speaking skills, voice modulation, and script writing for shows, radio dramas, editing, and other aspects of radio program production. A basic overview of the audio software would also be provided.

The students who are part of the program will have an opportunity to attend the theoretical and practical sessions conducted by the renowned personalities in the field, and will be given extensive reading materials. Students are expected to participate fully in the daily online classes and practical sessions of two hours each and submit the assignments given to them on time. The students have to pass the final written examination and produce one radio program of any genre as their project for the successful completion of the course. Certificates are provided for all students who complete the course.

Eligibility: Students from any stream, and pursuing undergraduate or postgraduate course

- improving the student's presentation abilities and training them in RJing and voiceover announcements
- Introduce the students to the potential of voice-based storytelling and assist them in training voice modulation methods.
- Develop scriptwriting abilities for radio programs.
- Get the pupils acquainted with program production and audio editing.

REPORT AND OUTCOME OF THE PROGRAM

A 35 hour of Scheduled classes and practical training were conducted for UG & PG students of Sree Ayyappa College. Program started from 10th February 2021 to 28th February 2021. 70 students have registered for the course. As part of the course, 18 hours of lectures and 17 hours of practical training were given by the scholars working in the various departments of All India Radio and other media. In addition to the final written exam, daily assignments and an end project were also submitted by the students for the successful completion of the course. Out of the 70 students registered for the course, 29 students successfully completed the course and they were awarded the course certificate.

Major Milestone and outcome of the program

- A fundamental knowledge of radio program genres was attained.
- Students developed the skills necessary to capture audio to a high level of professionalism and edit it to create a meaningful radio program.
- Voice over narration and radio script authoring strategies were studied.
- Students learned how to create their own programme ideas, and they were able to create their own radio programmes based on these concepts.
- Students received training in radio show hosting
