Introduction

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of our esteemed institution conducted a comprehensive Student Feedback Program for the academic year 2022-23. The primary objective of this initiative was to gather insights from students across various departments regarding the effectiveness of the curriculum, teaching methodologies, and assessment processes. The collected feedback aimed to contribute to ongoing efforts for continuous improvement in the quality of education provided by the institution.

Methodology

A well-structured questionnaire containing 10 different questions was designed to capture the diverse aspects of the academic experience. The questions focused on the innovative pedagogical approaches practiced by the faculty, the enhancement of participative and experiential learning, the development of analytical and problem-solving skills through the curriculum, and the fairness of the assessment and evaluation process. The feedback forms were distributed in classrooms, ensuring the participation of students from all departments. A total of 110 filled forms were collected, representing a significant and diverse sample of the student body.

Data Analysis

The collected data underwent a meticulous analysis to derive meaningful insights. The responses were categorized, and both quantitative and qualitative analyses were performed. The analysis aimed to identify areas of strength and areas that require attention and improvement.

Key Findings

One of the area which needed attention was scope in the syllabus in enhancing entrepreneurship skills/ life long learning human values and ethics. Another one was opportunities to demonstrate their innovative skills, leadership skills communication skills during the study.

Discussion and Remedial Measures

The research outcomes were eloquently unveiled and deliberated upon during the IQAC meeting on 5.9.2023, College Council, and College Level Monitoring Committee (CLMC) meetings on 1.12.2023 respectively. The discourse centered on devising corrective strategies to tackle the pinpointed areas necessitating enhancement. Notably, an observation surfaced regarding certain programs, such as BSc Computer Science, lacking the inclusion of internships and entrepreneurship in their curriculum.

In light of this, it is worth noting that Kerala University is poised to introduce four-year undergraduate programs in the upcoming academic year, encompassing a comprehensive framework inclusive of internships and entrepreneurship opportunities across all pathways. This forward-thinking initiative promises to rectify the identified lacuna and usher in a more holistic educational experience. Also, a consensus was reached to solicit proposals from the coordination of the Career Guidance Cell to enhance the students' innovative, leadership, and communication skills by organizing additional training sessions.

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
Conclusion




1.Departmentwise Anlysis











We express our gratitude to all the alumni who participated in the survey, contributing to the enhancement of our institution's educational endeavors.




5. Give your rating for the role of Alumni in the enhancement of academic program and required skills.




6. Give your rating for the role of Alumni in strengthening the departments.

Faculty Feedback on Curriculum REPORT 2022-23

Introduction

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Sree Ayyappa College conducted a comprehensive survey on the Faculty Feedback regarding the curriculum for the academic year 2022-23. The primary objective of this exercise was to gather insights into the faculty's perception of the existing curriculum and to identify areas for improvement. The survey was conducted through the Campus Genie Software, the College Learning Management System (LMS), to ensure efficient data collection and analysis.

Survey Methodology:

The survey consisted of 20 different questions, covering various aspects of the curriculum, teaching methodologies, and overall academic experience. Faculty members from all departments actively participated by entering their responses through the Campus Genie Software portal. In total, 237 responses were collected, representing a significant portion of the faculty body.

Data Analysis:

The collected data was subjected to rigorous analysis to derive meaningful insights. The analysis aimed to identify patterns, common concerns, and areas where improvements could be made. The findings were presented in two key forums: the College Council and the College Level Monitoring Committee (CLMC) Meetings, both held on December 1, 2023.

Key Findings:

The vast majority of feedback received has been overwhelmingly positive, highlighting the effectiveness of the program. However, there are specific areas that present opportunities for enhancement. These include refining seminar presentations, fostering more engaging group discussions and learner participation, achieving a harmonious balance between theory and application, and invigorating interest in the subject matter.

Discussion and Remedial Measures:

In response to diverse feedback concerning various curricula, a department-wise analysis is imperative to guide our actions. The respective departmental data has been disseminated for thorough discussion and the formulation of remedial measures during the upcoming Departmental Learning and Management Committee (DLMC) sessions
