

### **Students Feedback Analysis Report**




The college received a total of 70 responses from students, showcasing their perspectives on various aspects.

A significant 88% of students strongly agreed that the curriculum offers ample scope for acquiring profound knowledge and intellectual growth in specific domains. Similarly, an impressive 90% of students strongly agreed that the curriculum strikes a well-balanced combination of theory and practical aspects, incorporating laboratory work into the courses. The curriculum also received praise for its effectiveness in fostering analytical and problem-solving skills, with 85% of students agreeing that it facilitated their development in these areas. Furthermore, a remarkable 88% of students strongly agreed that the curriculum helps them become proficient in understanding and implementing the desired outcomes. Addressing broader skill sets, an encouraging 90% of students strongly agreed that the syllabus allows for the enhancement of entrepreneurship skills, instills a culture of lifelong learning, and promotes human values and ethics. 90% of students strongly agreeing that it enhances participative and experiential learning, creating an engaging academic environment. Moreover, an appreciable 89% of students agreed that the institution adheres to a fair assessment and evaluation system for grading students. Recognizing the importance of practical experiences, a notable 91% of students agreed that they have been provided with opportunities to demonstrate innovative, leadership, and communication skills during their studies. The curriculum's flexibility and responsiveness to students' interests and requirements were evident, as 95% of students agreed that they are offered options to select


elective courses, CBCS (Choice-Based Credit System), Values Added Courses, and Certification courses based on their interests and needs. Finally, an overwhelming 96% of students strongly agreed that the curriculum provides ample opportunities to excel in co-curricular and extracurricular activities, enriching their overall learning experience.

### **Alumni Feedback Analysis Report**



A total of 50 Alumni submitted feedback on the curriculum. 100% of alumni feel proud to be students of Sree Ayyappa College.82% of alumni agreed about the role of the institution and the curriculum in enhancing their employability skills and also their personality development. 84% of alumni have related maximum in the agreement that the Academic Programs are updated regularly as per the development and requirements of Society.81% have rated maximum about their the role of Alumni in the enhancement of academic program and required skills.. 79% alumni have agreed that alumni played an important role in strengthening the departments. 88% of alumni were motivated due to the curriculum content to pursue post-graduation and research.
