Procedure:





Students Feedback Analysis Report



Total of 102 responses students submitted their views on the curriculum. 90% of students strongly agreed that the curriculum has scope for acquiring strong knowledge and intellect on the specific domains. 88% of students strongly agreed that the curriculum has a good mix of theory and laboratory aspects of courses. 78% students agreed that the Curriculum facilitated in developing analytical and problem solving skills. 90% students strongly curriculum makes them proficient in understanding the outcome and complying with it. 92% students strongly agreed there is scope in the syllabus in enhancing entrepreneurship skills/ lifelong learning/ human values and ethics. 91% of students strongly agreed that the innovative pedagogical approach practiced by the faculty enhances participative learning and experiential learning. 84% of students agreed that the institution follows a fair assessment and evaluation of student grading. 88% of students agreed that they have been given opportunities to demonstrate innovative skills, leadership skills, and communication skills during study. 91% of students agreed that they are provided options to select elective courses/ CBCS/ Values Added Courses/ Certification courses etc of interest/requirement.96% of students strongly agreed that the opportunities in the curriculum provide to excel in co-curricular and extracurricular activities

Alumni Feedback Analysis Report




A total of 54 alumni participated in the feedback process, sharing their valuable perspectives on the curriculum at Sree Ayyappa College.

Notably, a significant 87% of alumni expressed a sense of pride in being associated with the institution. Moreover, an overwhelming 87% of alumni agreed that both the institution and its curriculum played instrumental roles in enhancing their employability skills and fostering personal development. The effectiveness of the academic programs was acknowledged, with 86% of alumni concurring that the curriculum is regularly updated to align with the evolving needs and advancements of society. The contribution of alumni to the enhancement of academic programs and the development of essential skills received high acclaim, with 81% of alumni giving top ratings to their involvement in this regard. The curriculum's impact on motivation was evident, as 75% of alumni credited the content for inspiring them to pursue post-graduation and engage in research. Additionally, a noteworthy 80% of alumni acknowledged the vital role played by alumni in strengthening the various departments of the college.

Overall, the feedback from alumni paints a positive picture of Sree Ayyappa College's curriculum, highlighting its effectiveness in instilling a sense of pride, imparting valuable skills, and fostering a spirit of academic pursuit and research.

Teachers Feedback Analysis Report
