Feedback report

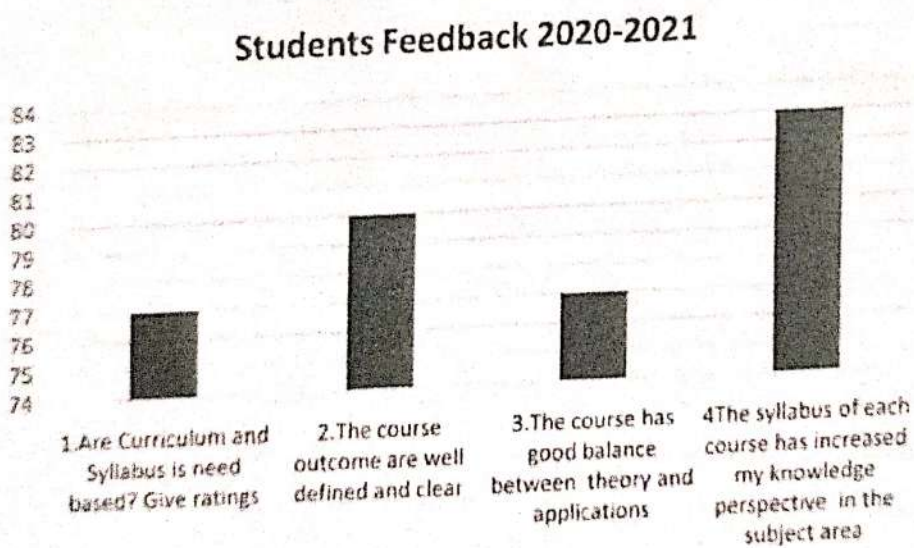

Students Feed back



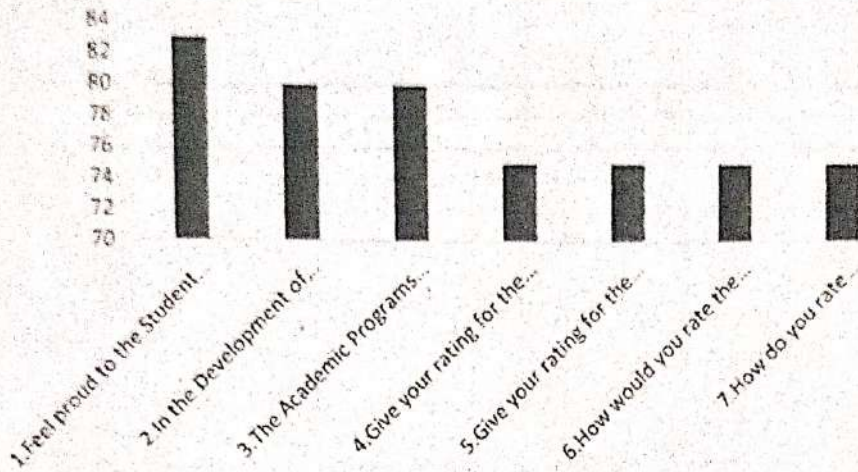
Total of 49 responses students submitted their views on the curriculum. 77% of students agreed that the curriculum and syllabus are need-based. 80% of students are in agreement with clarity in course outcomes. 77% of students feel that there is a good balance between theory and applications. 83% of students agreed about knowledge enhancement in the subject area.



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
Alumni Feedback

Alumni Feedback 2020-2021

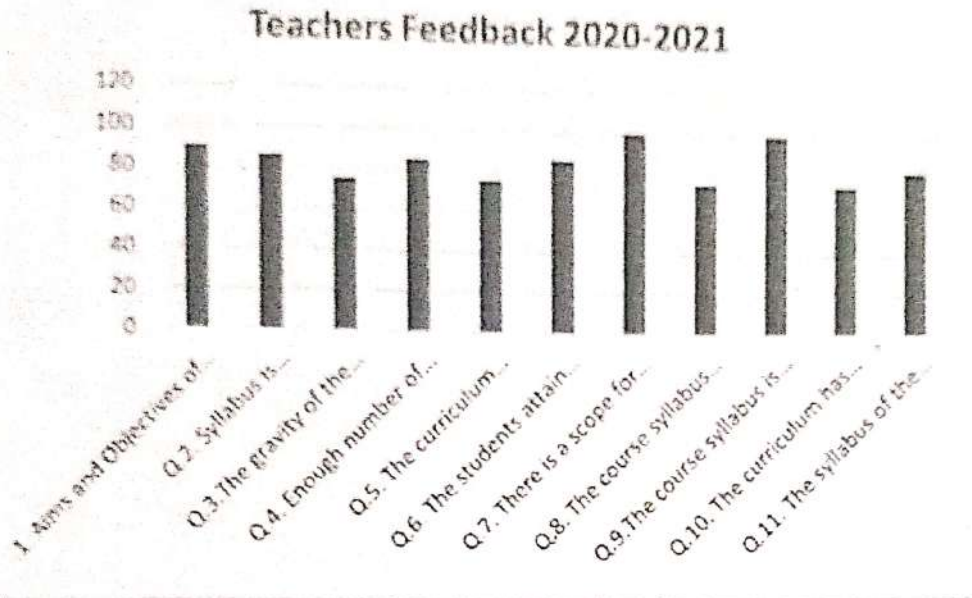


A total of 55 alumni submitted feedback on the curriculum. More than 80% of alumni feel proud to be students of Sree Ayyappa College. 80% of alumni agreed about the role of the institution and the curriculum in enhancing their employability skills and also their personality development. 80% of alumni have related maximum in the agreement of the inclusions of social requirements in academic programs, as the institution always motivates alumni participation in various activities and their suggestion about the curriculum. 75% of alumni have agreed to their participation in these activities. 75% have rated maximum about their help in strengthening the respective department. 75% of alumni were motivated due to the curriculum content to pursue post-graduation and research. 75% alumni have agreed with relevance of their degree and current working field.




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Teachers Feedback



Curriculum feedback has been submitted by 17 full time regular teachers. 90% of teachers agree that the aim and objectives are well defined and clear. 86% of teachers feel that the syllabus is need-based and contemporary. 75% of teachers have agreed about the adequacy of course content for significant learning outcomes. 85% of teachers said yes about the availability of required books. 75% of teachers agreed that the curriculum provides opportunities for research activities. 86% of teachers agreed about the attainment of course outcomes. 100% of teachers agreed that there is a scope for teaching techniques such as seminars, presentations, group discussions, and project works. 100% of teachers feel that the course syllabus has increased his/her knowledge in the respective subject area. 75% of teachers agreed that the curriculum has focused on skill development. 83% of teachers also agreed that the course syllabus emphasizes job-oriented skills.



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
