
Procedure

The action was taken: CLMC discussed the stakeholder's responses in the feedback form and the following decisions were taken


- 1. To send a request from the college to the PG Boardof studies to conduct a Faculty training Programme as the revised syllabus of MSc Computer Science have new tools to learn.
- Alumni participation in programmes to be enhanced as 78% of alumni responded that
 they would like tocontribute to theenhancement of academic programmes and
 required skills.
- 3. It is decided to constitute department alumni as a subsidiary of college alumnito strengthen the alumni contribution as 72% of alumni members have given feedback to strengthen department alumni.
- 4. Stakeholder's responses were analyzed and the summarised report will be communicated to The Registrar, University of Kerala for further action.

Students Feedback report




Totalof 115responses students submitted their views on the curriculum.88% of students agreed that the curriculum and syllabus are need-based.89% of students are in agreement with clarity in course outcomes.88% of students feel that there is a good balance between theory and applications.89% of students agreed about knowledge enhancement in the subject area.

Alumni Feedback report




A totalof 19 alumni members submitted feedback on the curriculum. 84% of alumni feel proud to be students of Sree Ayyappa College. 83% of alumni agreed about the role of the institution and the curriculum in enhancing their employability skills and also their personality development. 85% of alumni have related maximum in the agreement that the Academic Programs are updated regularly as per the development and requirements of Society.78% have rated maximum about their the role of Alumni in the enhancement of academic program and required skills.. 74% of alumni were motivated due to the curriculum content to pursue post-graduation and research. 72% alumni have agreed that alumni played an important role in strengthening the departments

Teachers Feedback report



Curriculum feedback has been submitted by 17 full time regular teachers. 93.33% teachers strongly agreed the Suitability of syllabus to the programs. 87% teachers agreed that the syllabus is need based. 93. 33% teachers strongly agreed Aims and objectives of the syllabi are well defined. 73% teachers agreed that sufficient number of prescribed books and reference materials available in the library. 80% teachers agreed that the Curriculum generates interest in the subject area.87% teachers strongly agreed that the curriculum has prospects for higher education/employability. 87% teachers strongly agreed that the syllabus has a good balance between theory and application. 93% of teachers strongly agreed that the Curriculum ensures seminar presentation, group discussion and learners participation. 100% of teachers strongly agreed that the Curriculum gives scope for project/ internship. 87% of teachers strongly agreed that the college provides adequate facilities for online classes.



A total of 3 employers have submitted a response on curriculum feedback. 80% of employers agreed about the inclusion of both theory and practical sessions in the curriculum. 80% of respondents agreed that the curriculum includes project/dissertation/field visits for real-life experiential learning.80% of respondents agreed that the curriculum imparts knowledgeand skills for the job market.80% of respondents said yes about providing the scope for acquiringemployable and entrepreneurship skills.80% of respondents agreed tothe clarity of the course objectives and structured modules.Overall 88% of stakeholders from various categories agreed that the curriculum fulfils their expectations.
