ACTION PLAN 2020-21

The unforeseen outbreak of COVID 19 pandemic in March 2020, caused a drastic change in the traditional teaching-learning process. The teaching and student community were compelled to find ways in sustaining the academic routine through online mode. We could see that there was a nationwide movement in training and equipping students as well as teachers to different modes of online learning. The pandemic situation fuelled our initiative towards a blended teaching-learning process. Our faculty utilized variant modes of online teaching such as Google classroom, G-meet, YouTube channel, and personalised Moodle links. We have ensured participation of the students and teachers to develop self-learning aptitude through various certificate courses offered by SWAYAM-NPTEL and international platform named Coursera . Our institution also adopted a strategic plan with a perspective to adapt to the pandemic oriented alternative teaching-learning methods. As per the discussions we concluded to implement the following:

- We decided to direct our teachers to participate in different refresher courses to educate themselves on various online platforms for online teaching.
- Our institution is in dire need of a G-suite facility to enhance the data capacity of the official mail ids and Google classrooms with superior features. Therefore, measures will be taken to resolve this issue.
- Our faculty members have decided to share their study materials, online classes and other resources via YouTube channel, google classrooms and the students can access all the resources from their respective department resource page of the college website.
- We also lack a common Learning Management System (LMS) platform to accommodate all our students and their various courses.
- IQAC is organized training workshops for our teachers to familiarize them with the personalised MOODLE platform.
- We expect that the successful implementation of this strategic plan can directly benefit the College in the following ways:
- Boosting the technical capability of the teachers thereby evolving them as resource persons for conducting training programmes
- Keeping the academic pace of the student community in this rural part of the country in phase with their peer students with benefits.
- Encouraging the students and teachers to exploit this opportunity for futuristic benefits of blended learning post COVID.
