Criteria for consideration includes, but not specifically restricts on to:

- ◆ Only original contributions
- ◆ Abstracts not exceeding 250 words on any of the sub-themes
- ◆ Abstracts/ Full paper should be sent in soft copy, Font Times New Roman (Title and Sub heading size 14, subject matter size 12), Line Spacing 1.5, in pdf. Hard copies neednot be sent, unless asked for.
- ◆ Selected abstracts will be permitted for oral presentation and the extended abstracts will be published electronically as Proceedings of the Conference with ISBN/ISSN.
- ◆ Accepted abstracts will be intimated to the corresponding authors to the mail ID provided in the abstract.
- ◆ The decision of the Review committee regarding the acceptance of the paper will be final.

❖ Important points to be noted

- ◆ Maximum number of words: 250-300
- ◆ Details containing Title, Name and Official address (including pin code) of Author(s) with their Email Ids
- ◆ Abstracts should contain keywords, if any
- ◆ The best presentations will be selected for awards and e-certificate of merit awarded
- ◆ Presentation certificate will be issued only to authors and co-authors who have registered and paid the necessary fees for the webinar. For this purpose, fees of co-authors must be paid independently
- ◆ Abstracts and screen shots of payment of fees clearly specifying the names and details of co-authors independently (if any) should be sent clearly specifying under which sub theme it is to be considered, with tag line "Abstract and Fee payment details for Infofest012"
- ◆ The above information may be mailed to infofest@sreeayyapcollege.ac.in
- ◆ No further communication will be entertained on any of the above rules

❖ Presentation strategy

- ◆ Virtual mode using online platform Zoom/Google meet and live broadcast on YouTube
- ◆ Time: Presentation (7 minutes), Clarifications (3 minutes)
- ◆ Power points of the presentations should be sent on or before the date specified, which will be intimated to the corresponding authors of the accepted papers, in addition to a video recording of the presentation by the author who intends to present, to be telecast, if needed, considering connectivity issues, if any. However, the presenter should be online for clarification in real time

❖ Registration for the webinar

- ◆ Only registered participants will be permitted to attend the webinar.
- ◆ For registration, kindly fill the google form appended
- ◆ If presenting a paper, it has to be mentioned in the field provided, the abstract communicated within the specified time, and the necessary fees paid
