Report on one day National seminar and Exhibition on Wetland friendly solar energy sources for climate change – 2019

Theme of the seminar

World wetland day is celebrated every year on 2nd February. This day marks the date of the adoption of the convention wetlands on 2nd February 1971, in the Iranian city of Ramsar.

Summary of Wetland Day 2019 programme

This summary captures a one-day programme of Invited lecture, discussions and competitions based on Wetland friendly solar energy sources for climate change on 31st January, 2019. The seminar was organized by Sree Ayyappa College, Eramallikkara and funded by Kerala State council for Science, Technology and Environment, Thiruvananthapuram.

The event brought together some 150 delegates in and around schools and colleges to participate in the wetland day programme – 2019. The National seminar on wetland began with opening remarks by Invited talks given by the environmentalists. It concluded with a set of competitions of essay writing and drawing based on the theme of Wetland.

Session 1: Welcome and opening statements (09:15 am to 10:30 am)

Opening the National seminar event, the registration was started at 09:15 am onwards on 31st January, 2019. The prayer song was given by Ms. Sherin and Ms. Reema of III B.Sc. Mathematics at 10:00 am. The inaugural function was chaired by Principal Dr. K.S. Anil Kumar. The convenor of the seminar Dr. R.T. Ananth Kumar welcomed the gathering. The lighting of the lamp was done by the dignitaries of the dais. The felicitation address were given by Prof. K.C. Prakash (IQAC Co-ordinator and Associate Professor of Electronics) and Dr. Nitha B (Science Club Co-ordinator & Assistant Professor of Microbiology) of Sree Ayyappa College Chengannur. The vote of thanks was given by Dr. G. Ganga (Joint Convenor & Assistant Professor of Microbiology) of Sree Ayyappa College Chengannur.

Session 2 : Academic session (10 : 45 am to 12 : 45 am) : Invited Lecture

The featured speaker of Invited lecture I was given by Dr. Brilliant Rajan, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Environmental Science, St. John's College, Anchal, Kollam District, Kerala on the topic "Wetland and Climate Change". The talk was focussed on the wetland usage using the adverse technology of solar energy without affecting the environment. The talk also stated that, we are losing wetlands three times faster than forests. Also directly or indirectly, wetlands provide almost all of the world's consumption of fresh water and more than 40 % of all species live and breed in wetlands. Some interesting questions were raised by the students and it was a nice presentation by Dr. Brilliant Rajan.

The second invited lecture began at 11:45 am by Dr. Abhilash R, Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology, Christian College, Chengannur – 689121, Kerala. The topic was on "Wetlands: A natural solution to Climate Change". He stated that, wetlands are best known to prevent flooding. Because the plant and the soil in all different sorts of wetlands is used to being saturated with water, it can hold onto the water better than other areas. Water that falls as precipitation or that flows down from mountains in streams or that is present in the ground is caught and held in wetlands, which prevents other areas, perhaps further downhill, from flooding. The lecture was ended at 12:45 pm.

As Chengannur was the most affected area by the recent flood 2018 in Kerala, the seminar on Wetland was very useful and was widely accepted by the academic community and students.

Session 3: Academic session (01: 30 pm to 03:30 pm): Competition for students

After the post lunch, around 01:30 pm Essay competition is English and Malayalam were conducted for School and College students. Time of 45 minutes was given for essay competition. The topic for Essay competition is "The need of wetland protection in Kerala" and in total 31 students participated in it. Among school level, Parvathy (Std: IX) of K.S.G Hr. Sec. School, Kadapra was awarded the first prize in essay writing.

At 02:15 pm drawing competition were started and around 21 students participated in it. The topic given was "Wetland and climate change, Rain water harvesting". Chart papers, pencil, crayon, water colour, sketch pen, painting brush etc were provided to the students.

Based on the topic of "Wetland conservation, Importance and need of wetland, Rainwater harvesting, Basic lighting using solar energy, Battery storage and irrigation in wetland areas under solar energy, Street lighting in wetland areas, Recharging of communication devices using solar energy" few exhibitions were also exhibited by the students.

The valedictory session started at 03:00 pm. The prizes were distributed to the winners by Prof. K.C. Prakash (IQAC Co-ordinator and Associate Professor of Electronics).




Fig. 16 Drowing competition




Fig. 24 Drowing




Fig. 19 Drawing by & delegates
