As per UGC regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions-2009, an Anti Ragging Committee and Anti Ragging Squad and Anti Ragging Mentoring Cell was re-constituted to prohibit ragging activities inside the campus. Steps were to be taken for issuing the proceeding of the Principal on this matter. The details were uploaded in the website of the college. The brochure of admission was printed with the regulations and helpline numbers

Public declaration that ragging is totally prohibited in the campus before the admission starts. A meeting of the Anti ragging Mentoring Cell was convened. Short films uploaded by UGC are to be screened for senior students before the commencement of first year classes. Affidavit by student and parent were collected online after admission and the same were printed and filed. Steps were taken by the Head of the institution to convene a meeting(faculty members, parents, student representatives, hostel wardens etc) before the commencement of an academic session and explained the various measures to be taken to prevent ragging and the minutes of the meeting was entered in the minutes book. Posters and notices were displayed in the campus to make awareness about regulations and punishments. Instructions were issued by the head of the institution to have a close watch at vulnerable places and tighten the security. Printed leaflet(which includes the regulations, helpline numbers, anti ragging squad members details) are to be provided for freshers. Guidelines were provided to Committees (course in charges, student advisor, wardens, senior representatives) to promote healthy relationships. Authenticated that separate blocks in hostels for freshers and round the clock vigil in hostel premises were provided.
