ADMISSION: RULES

- Admission to all classes is governed by the rules laid down by the Govt. of Kerala and the University of Kerala from time to time.
- Application for admission should be made in the prescribed form available in the college office on payment of Rs.50/-
- No student who has provisionally studied in a recognized school or college (including Sree Ayyappa College, Eramallikkara) shall be admitted to the college unless he/she produces transfer certificate in the proper format.
- Students who came from other universities must produce the eligibility certificate and migration certificate before admission
- No student will be enrolled or allowed to attend any class until the fee due from him/ her is paid
- No. Student of the college will be allowed to attend any other course of study or any other institution before obtaining withdrawal from the college.
- Any candidate who is found to have obtained admission through false representation will be dismissed and will forfeit whatsoever fees he/she may have paid.

CODE OF CONDUCT- RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Observe neat and pleasing dress code. Be courteous and decent in behaviour. Speak politely.
- As the prayer begins, come to attention wherever you are and join the prayer. Move only after the song is over.
- Rise and greet your teacher as she/he enters the class-room.
 Rise and offer your thanks when the teacher leaves the class-room
- When the session is on you will enter the class only with the permission of the teacher.
- Due respect will be given to the staff both inside and outside the campus. It is rude behavior to enter a room without being permitted, to jump queues, to scramble for seat in bus, to get past a person without saying "Excuse me" or not to say "Sorry" if you have bumped someone.
- Students who do not have class or laboratory work shall remain in the reading room or in vacant class rooms. Loitering in the veranda or premises is not permitted.
- Any student who is persistently or willfully insubordinate, or is guilty of fraud or malpractice in connection with examinations, uses abusive and offensive language to any member of the staff

- or fellow student, will be penalized and dismissed after appropriate enquiry.
- Notices shall not be circulated nor shall they be displayed without the permission of the Principal.
- Smoking or indulging in other reprehensible habits is forbidden within the premises.
- Mass meeting of any kind shall not be held within the premises without the prior sanction of the Principal.
- Use of mobile phone by students inside the campus is strictly prohibited.
- Ragging is a very serious criminal offence under Kerala Ragging Prohibition Act 1998 and is punishable with 2 years imprisonment along with a penalty of Rs.10000/-. Such students will be expelled from the institution and they will not be given admission to any other educational institution for a period of three years (Kerala Ragging Prohibition Act 1998).

EXAMINATIONS AND TEST PAPERS: RULES

- Exemption from attendance at examinations and test papers is granted by the Principal on the recommendation of the concerned Head of the Department.
- Application for such exemption must be made at least two days before the commencement of the examination.
- Absence from examination and test papers without leave will render the students concerned liable to serious punishment which may result in with-holding of Term Certificate.
- When re-examination is offered, absence from such examination for any reason what-so-ever will be regarded as equivalent to failure. Suitable fee may be collected from students to whom reexamination is offered.
- Malpractice in test papers and examinations will render a student liable to severe punishment or expulsion from the college.

LIBRARY AND READING ROOM: RULES

- Students are expected to make the maximum use of the library and reading room facilities provided in the college.
- Strict silence should be maintained inside the library and the reading room.
- The library will be open from 9.30am to 4.00pm on all days on which the college office is open.
- Nothing except writing materials shall be taken inside the reading room and library.

- Books must be returned within 14days from the date of issue.
- A fine of 1 Rs. per day will be charged per book if not returned on the due date, until the book is returned or its loss reported.
- Books must be carefully examined at the time of issue. The borrower shall be held liable for any damage detected later.
- Tearing of picture or any other type of mutilation of magazine, book, etc. is serious offence. The borrower shall be asked to replace such book, at his/ her cost.
- The loss of any book must be immediately reported to the librarian and with his permission the book may be replaced by a new volume failing which its cost as decided by the librarian must be paid.
- Sub-lending of books is strictly forbidden.
- All books issued from the library shall be returned without fail on or before the last working day of the academic year.

CAUTION DEPOSIT: RULES OF COLLECTION AND REFUND

- All students shall in admission to the college be liable to pay the
 caution deposit prescribed for that installment of tuition fees and
 other special fees payable on the date of admission at the
 commencement of a course along with such terms of less as are
 to be paid under the rules in case where the admission takes
 place during the period of a course, as the case may be.
- Students belonging to scheduled caste/scheduled tribes/other eligible communities are exempted from payment of caution deposit.
- The caution deposit paid by a student for a particular course shall be retained in the institution till completion of the course of study. Caution deposit received from a student will be refunded to him/her on receipt of application form prescribed and after adjusting the dues, if any, on account of:
 - Loss of Library books and fine thereof.
 - Fine for breakages of laboratory equipment and any other loss caused to properties of the college.
 - Arrears of fee, if any.
 - If the caution deposit is less that the amount to be realized from the student excess amount will be realized by other means as the principal may decide.
- The caution deposit paid by a student for a particular course the institution shall be refunded to him/her after adjusting dues if any, before completion of the course in the college, if the student applied for refund of the same and provided further that the

- student takes TC from the college concerned on grounds of discontinuing the course or for pursing studies for the same or a different course in some other institution.
- It shall be the responsibility of the student to claim the refund of caution deposit paid by him/her for the particular course immediately after the closing date of the college after the expiry of the academic year in which the course is completed or earlier when the claim of refund arises under the circumstances stated in Rule (4) above.
- If any student has been promoted to higher class on once or more occasions or has discontinues studies for one or more above claiming refund shall be extended by such number of academic year of break.
- The students should keep in safe custody the receipts issued for remittance of the caution deposit during the tenure of the course. The Caution deposit will be refunded only if the concerned receipt issued from the college is produced along with the application for refund of the caution deposits. Exemption from the operation this rule may be granted by the Principal in genuine cases where the original receipt is not in a position to be produced and provided, the Principal is personally satisfied about the identity of the applicant claiming the refund.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE OF ABSENCE

- Percentage of attendance shall be calculated Course-wise. To determine the eligibility for registration for the End Semester Examination, the average of the course-wise percentage of attendance shall be considered.
- Those who secure a minimum of 75% attendance in the aggregate of all the course of a semester taken together alone will be allowed to register for the end semester examination of the semester.
- Condemnation of attendance to a maximum of 10 days in a semester subject to a maximum of two times during the whole period of a Degree Program may be granted by the University. Benefits of attendance may be granted to students who attend to University Union activities, meeting of University bodies and participation in extracurricular activities by treating as present for the days of their absence for the above purpose on production of participation/attendance certificate in such activities issued by the University Authorities/Principals, subject to a maximum of 10 days in a semester. Those who secure a minimum of 75% attendance in the aggregate of all the Course of a Semester

taken together alone will be allowed to register for the End Semester Examination of the Semester.

- A statement of attendance earned by the student will be published every month in the notice board. Students shall examine the lost and report the discrepancies, if any, to the class tutor
- Students are not permitted to abstain from classes without leave for the whole or part of a day.
- Absence without leave for part of a day will entail forfeiture of attendance for the whole day.
- A student absent from the college for more than fifteen consecutive working days without satisfactory explanation is liable to have his\her name removed from the rolls.
- Leave of absence should be obtained from the Principal on the recommendation of the head of the Department/Class Teacher concerned. As far as possible, leave should be obtained beforehand. If application for leave is not on clear or satisfactory grounds, the student may be called upon to explain.
- Students who are obliged to leave a class owing to indisposition shall obtain endorsement from the mentor of the class.
- Application for leave for more than three days at a time should be supported either by a letter from the parent/guardian or by a medical certificate in cases of illness.
- Duty leave for physical education activities and youth festival will be granted only to athletes representing the College or University in various matches, tournaments and sports event.
- A student deputed to participate in matches, tournaments and sports events, should submit his/her leave application duly recommended by the Lecturer in Physical Education to the Class Teacher concerned for necessary action not later than one week after the event.
- The maximum period for which duty leave can be granted to a student for sports and athletic activities is limited to 10% of the total number of working days.

CONTINUOUS EVALUATION

20% of the total evaluation is continuous. Periodical examinations are conducted and evaluated. Based on this and other parameters like assignments, seminars and attendance grades are awarded for CE. The grade awarded for CE will be at par with the performance of the student in various components of CE.

ANTI RAGGING CELL

SCHOLARSHIPS AND OTHER AMENITIES

Scholarships, Fee Concession Students Aid Funds & Awards

- (a) Scheduled Caste, Schedule tribe, Christian converts and other Eligible community students are eligible for full fee concession, Lump Sum Grant and Stipend. These Students are eligible for the benefit irrespective of family income and marks. They have to produce the required documents for fee concession.
- (b) Other backward community students whose annual family income does not exceed Rs.25000/-, of Degree course (annual scheme) are eligible for full fee concession. Such students have to submit income certificate in the prescribed form issued by the Village Officer and countersigned by the Panchayat President/Municipal Commissioner

VARATTAR PROJECT

Varattar is a tributary of the Pamba River, the third longest river in the South Indian state of Kerala. It flows through the outskirts of Chengannur. The public living in the outskirts of Varattar faces various major health issues due to the present condition of the Varattar. Hence the present study is carried out by the Department of Microbiology of our college. Dr. Ganga.G and Dr. Nitha.B of Microbiology Department co-ordinates the Varattar Project. The study aimed to evaluate presence of pathogenic microorganisms, oxygen content, pH level and total dissolved solids of water samples from different locations of Varattar. Water samples were taken from four different areas of Varattar River near Thiruvanvandoor Grama panchayath. The results indicate that water samples from Varattar were contaminated with heavy load of coliforms. The oxygen content of the water sample is very low and the pH was slightly acidic. The study concludes that the water samples collected from Varattar river is found to be unfit for

consumption or any other purposes and also for the growth of normal water inhabitants."
